Declaration of Commitment

Under this declaration, the undersigned publisher commits to comply with the following criteria, which are indispensable prerequisites for the (co-)financing of an open access publication by the SLUB Dresden:

1. The publication will be submitted to a peer-review or review process according to subject-specific standards.
2. The open access version of the publication will be made publicly accessible immediately upon publication, clearly visible, free of charge, and without any financial, legal, or technical barriers on the publisher's website.
3. The open access version will be published at least simultaneously with any planned paid versions, such as a print version.
4. The website and the publisher's own advertising materials will clearly indicate that there is an open access version of the publication, together with any paid versions.
5. All versions of the publication will indicate that an open access version exists.
6. Long-term archiving is guaranteed by a certified service (e.g., DNB, CLOCKSS, Portico).
7. The open access publication will receive a DOI.
8. Text and Data Mining (TDM) will be technically enabled and legally permitted, including

the automatic downloading, extraction, and indexing of full texts and metadata.

9. The metadata will contain at least the following information: title and any subtitle, author(s), editor(s), ORCID IDs (if available) or other suitable persistent identifiers for persons, standardized affiliations of the author(s) or editor(s) (e.g., ROR), publication date, publisher, any series title, any volume number, DOI, any ISBN (if available for a print edition), Open Access license information, abstract, keywords.
10. The metadata (including abstracts, keywords, and any thumbnails) will be made available under the CC0 1.0 Universal license.
11. The open access publication will be listed in DOAB and/or OAPEN.
12. The publication will be released under a Creative Commons 4.0 license.
13. The publisher will receive only non-exclusive rights of use from the author(s) or editor(s) for the planned open access publication, even if the publication is released under a more restrictive Creative Commons license (including NC and/or ND).
14. The open access license information will be included in the imprint of the publication and embedded in the file in a machine-readable format, and will be clearly indicated on the publisher's website.
15. If the research was supported by a funder, this will be indicated in the publication and in the metadata, in accordance with the funder's guidelines.
16. In the case of shared financing of the open access publication to different billing addresses, the publisher assures that the costs from the cost breakdown (see below) will not be exceeded in the shared invoicing or invoiced twice to different billing addresses.

In the event of a financing approval by SLUB Dresden, the publisher acknowledges that SLUB Dresden reserves the right to revoke or reclaim the financial support made available to the author(s) or editor(s) if one or more of the above points are not fulfilled by the publisher.
