Responsibilities

- you will coordinate the technical aspects of the further development of our publisher-independent Open Access publishing software
- you will examine the implementation of additional plug-ins in Open Journal Systems, implement them as required and lead the commissioning of IT developments to increase its attractiveness (provision of individual themes, connection to external data and publication infrastructures)
- you evaluate suitable software solutions for the publication of books
- you design the technical integration of low-threshold publication formats such as blogs and podcasts
- you will support the technical development of our repository (e.g. integration of persistent identifiers and usage statistics)
- you will contribute to the migration to the Library Service Platform FOLIO with your technical expertise, bearing the requirements of the OA publication platform in mind
- you will design and establish customised services for the engineering disciplines at the TU Dresden
- you will be the central contact person for all library-related questions, for the departments of electrical engineering/electronics and transport sciences and ensure the supply of information to these areas

Requirements

- University degree in Engineering or a comparable relevant discipline (e.g. computer science, information science, data science)
- IT skills preferably in the areas of mark-up languages (e.g. XML, HTML, LaTeX), transformation and stylesheet languages (e.g. XSL, CSS), scripting and programming languages (e.g. PHP, Javascript, Python), database systems and languages (e.g. MySQL)
- experience in setting up, maintaining and operating digital services
- very strong interest in technical aspects of Open Science
- willingness to familiarise yourself with new technologies and tasks
- analytical, responsible and creative thinking
- independent, goal- and solution-oriented way of working
- social competence, understanding of service and ability to communicate and work in a team
- speaking English fluently, basic German skills and willingness and ability to improve quickly
- knowledge of scientific publication infrastructures and/or software systems (e.g. Open Journal Systems, Editorial Manager) is desirable as well as

- knowledge of current developments in the field of open access publishing
